Colorado ACDA's 3-day workshop always features choral clinicians in the top of the field. This July, as part of the workshop, composer and conductor, **Dr. Rollo Dilworth** will be directing a choir comprised of **middle/junior school students**. To be eligible to participate, students must be entering 6th through 9th grade. Your students will learn some wonderful music and be encouraged by singing with many other students from across our state.

Middle or junior high school choral directors must click the **REGISTRATION** tab. You will find how to submit the names of your most talented singers (designate SAT or B) and the rehearsal schedule. There is a \$35 non-refundable participation fee for each student to cover expenses of music, a t-shirt, and pizza (Tuesday lunch is provided). The **Middle School Honor Choir** will perform in concert at the church Tuesday evening. The concert is free and open to the public.

Rollo A. Dilworth is Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities and Music Education at the North Park University School of Music in Chicago, Illinois. He also serves as director of the Music Institute of Chicago Children's Choir. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Music Education from Case Western Reserve University, and a Master of Education Degree in Secondary Education from the University of Missouri-St. Louis, where he studied composition and choral music with Robert Ray. He received the Doctor of Music degree in conducting performance at Northwestern University
